STAFFING

Camps will be staffed by RFU accredited rugby coaches and the highest safety measures will be taken. All supervisory and lead staff will have minimum possession of:

- England Rugby Coaching Award (Or Level 2 equivalent)
- First-Aid
- Valid, Checked and Cleared Disclosure & Barring Services Certificate
- Safeguarding certificate

DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY

By signing these terms and conditions you acknowledge and agree that NORTHAMPTON RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB is not responsible for any:

- Loss or damages of whatsoever nature and howsoever arising;
 - o injuries of any nature that your child may suffer;
 - o loss of or damage to property

Nothing in these terms and conditions shall limit our liability for death or personal injury caused by our negligence or the negligence of our employees.

BULLYING

On all Northampton Saints rugby camps, we uphold the values of our sport and in particular, our SPIRIT values: Sportsmanship, Pride, Integrity, Respect, Innovation and Teamwork. We also prioritise ensuring that each and every child has the best possible experience when on one of our rugby camps, and therefore practice a zero-tolerance policy when it comes to bullying. Our delivery team will address every and any issue that we witness or have reported to us. Any child on camp that is found to be bullying can be removed and requested to be picked up from camp, with no right to a refund.

CANCELLATIONS / REFUNDS

Non-Residential Camps: Cancellations made six weeks or more prior to the camp start date will have the following options:

- A 50% refund of course fee
- Move to a similar course (subject to price alteration, no refund will be made on a cheaper course)
- Have a credit note applied to your account
- In the event of an external factor causing the cancellation of a camp (e.g. extreme weather conditions), a suitable alternative will be provided and communicated accordingly

Any cancellation made within six weeks of the camp start date will not be refunded.

Residential Camps: Cancellations made six weeks or more prior to the camp start date will be entitled to a 50% refund of the total amount paid year-to-date.

Any cancellation made within six weeks of the camp start date will not be refunded.

Medical Absence: In the event of being unable to attend any of our camps due to a medical issue, we will honour a camp credit of the same value paid at our discretion, which can be applied to any other rugby camp product and must be used within 12 months. We

KIT LIST

This list is only a suggestion – should participants not have anything that is on the list please do not purchase items unless necessary.

- Rugby boots or appropriate footwear <u>and</u> Trainers
- Rugby training kit, to include waterproof top and a hat
- Protective equipment
- Gum shield / mouthguard if aged Under-9 or above (we strongly recommend that each participant wears a gum shield)
- Change of clothing for wet-weather conditions
- Drinks bottle
- Towel
- Insect repellent and insect bite cream
- Sunscreen

Please remember: A warm, dry child is a happy child. Some of the items on this list are seasonal. Activities are subject to weather conditions. In the event of camp cancelations or changes we will endeavour to notify you as soon as possible.
