Background

- Turbulent family background which impacted on living circumstances
- Referred to Engage Plus through Northampton College due to a lack of engagement
- Often partaking in anti-social behaviour and barred from retail and entertainment sites
- Had been suspended from the Engage Plus programme for two weeks, due to threatening behaviour, attitude rapidly changed as a result.

Interventions

- Successfully engaged four days a week in classroom sessions and enrichment activities
- Completed a variety of hands-on work experience to improve employability
- Positive relationships made with staff and peers creating healthy, sociable and trust working environment
- Successfully achieved 5 accredited qualifications
