Pupils with medical needs

The Foundation is made aware of participants with medical needs through their educational providers and on their referral forms. Copy of EHCP's will be requested where medical needs have been identified to ensure needs of the young person can be met.

It requires having the suitable level of insurance that accurately reflects the risk level, with risk assessments conducted when necessary.

Any medical conditions will need to be disclosed for participants to participate in Foundation trips and sporting activities and not prevent them from doing so.

Staff at the Foundation will remind the participant when to take their medicine but will not be solely responsible for how and when a participant takes their medicine or the storage.

It is the parents and educational providers responsibility to provide the Foundation with up-to-date information on a participant's medical records.

Medical emergencies will be dealt with under the Foundation's emergency procedures.
